With the suspension of Medicaid Managed Care in North Carolina, many people have been asking "What happens now?"

While we do not know what the future holds for Medicaid Managed Care implementation, we do know we need to continue our preparation for value based care and contracting.

As we learn more about the new timetable of Medicaid Managed Care, we will keep you informed.

Our focus in the coming months will be on making sure CCPN continues to fulfill its core mission: To establish a physician -led, innovative, high performing primary care network across North Carolina, which will support continuous quality improvement through evidence-based data metrics and best practices.

CCPN will strive to help you lower your operating costs and support reimbursement models which reflect the value of the care you provide and allow your practice to thrive so you can continue to take great care of your patients.

Just because Medicaid Managed Care will not begin next month as was planned, does not mean that our work is on hold.

CCPN still has many opportunities as commercial and government payers move towards value based care and reimbursement models.

## Medicaid Managed Care Suspended

On November 19, 2019, the NC Department of Health and Human Services (NC DHHS) issued a press release advising that North Carolina's transition to Medicaid Managed Care has been suspended.

While this is important news, it doesn't change CCPN's commitment to supporting North Carolina's independent clinicians as you continue to serve your patients.

CCPN is ready for the new Medicaid system no matter what implementation timetable the state establishes.

We have a strong regional system with boots on the ground ready to assist you with care management, provider services, and quality improvement support in all 100 counties.

NC Medicaid will continue to operate under the current fee-for-service model administered by NC DHHS.

Nothing will change for Medicaid beneficiaries and all health providers enrolled in Medicaid are still part of the program and will continue to bill the state through NCTracks.

The North Carolina Enrollment Broker Call Center closed on December 13, 2019.

Notices have been sent via mail to beneficiaries informing them to continue accessing health services as they do now rather than through the new health plans.

We will keep you informed on news related to North Carolina's transition to Medicaid Managed Care and continue to work to make the transition as smooth as possible for our Clinicians.

## CCPN Behavioral Health Clinician Update

CCPN has worked over the last several months to communicate with the NC Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS) and the Medicaid Prepaid Health Plans (PHPs) regarding concerns with the initial behavioral health care rates in the Medicaid PHP contracts.

Presently, WellCare and UnitedHealthcare have agreed to update their contract rates for our behavioral health clinicians and discussions continue with Healthy Blue, AmeriHealth Caritas, and Carolina Complete Health about how they will address this issue.

The CCPN Behavioral Health Workgroup continues to meet monthly.

The workgroup has been providing valuable input into the discussions about the fee schedule and other matters which are important for CCPN's behavioral health clinicians.

In addition, Dr. Karen Melendez and other key CCPN and CCNC staff have kept the workgroup up-todate on key issues which impact CCPN's behavioral health clinicians including but not limited to:

- Suspension of North Carolina's transition to Medicaid Managed Care/ Negotiations with the Medicaid PHPs
- Tailored Plan Care Management Request for Proposals
- Potential for utilizing the PracticePerfect<sup>SM</sup>
  CareImpact<sup>SM</sup> Dashboard to improve management for patients who receive behavioral health services
- New ways to engage with key decision makers across North Carolina and share the message about the importance of high quality, accessible behavioral health services

The CCPN Behavioral Health Workgroup meets on the fourth Wednesday of each month from 1:00pm - 2:00pm via conference call/webinar.
